Start with a 11" x 4 1/4" piece of cardstock

Score it at 3" , 5.50" and 8"

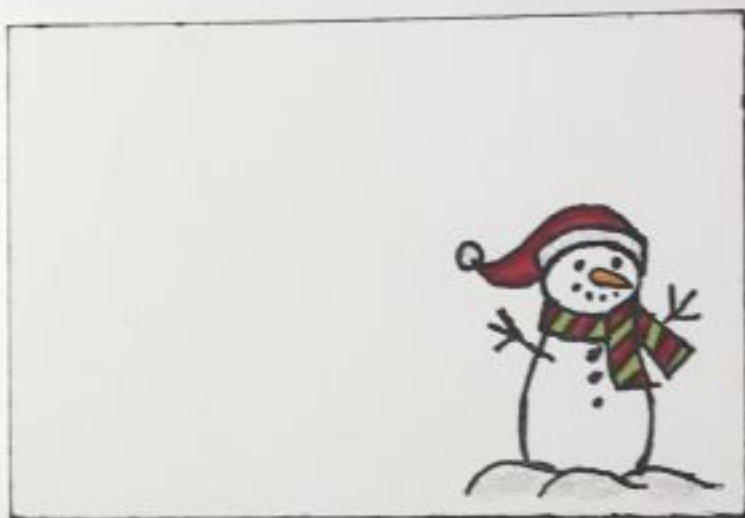
PAPER - REAL RED 4.25 x 11
SCORED - 3" 5.50" 8"



2.75 x 4.00
DSP of your choice

STAMP - JAR OF CHEER
STAMP IN' BLENDS - LIGHT CHERRY COBBLER
LIGHT OLD OLIVE
WINK OF STELLA BRUSH - CLEAR
INK - MEMENTO TUXEDO BLACK
PAPER - WHISPER WHITE THICK

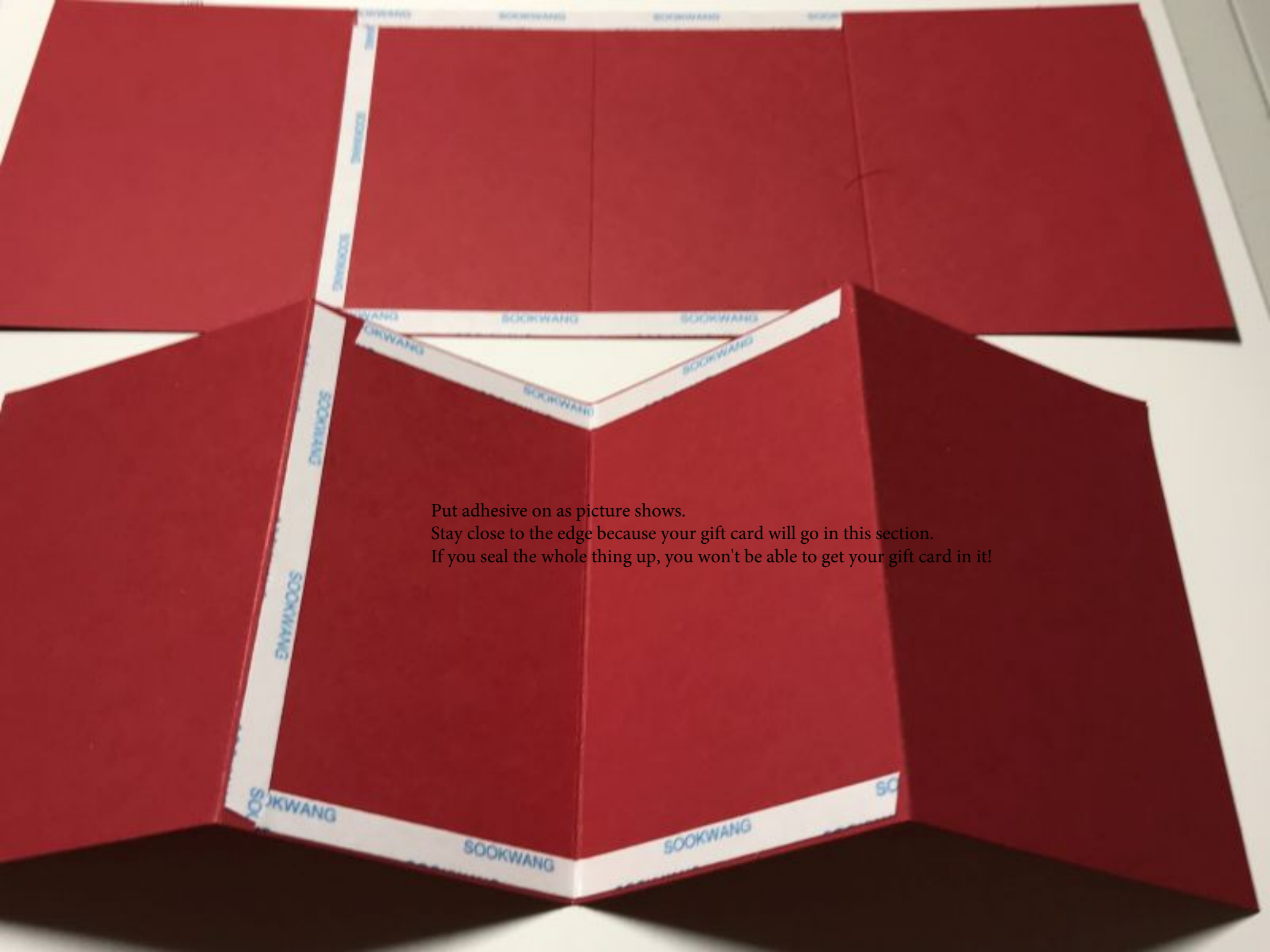


FRAMELITS -

Using a Punch of your choice, punch only about 1/3 to 1/2 of it. This step is just so the recipient can grip their gift card to pull it out.






Put adhesive on as picture shows.

Stay close to the edge because your gift card will go in this section.

If you seal the whole thing up, you won't be able to get your gift card in it!

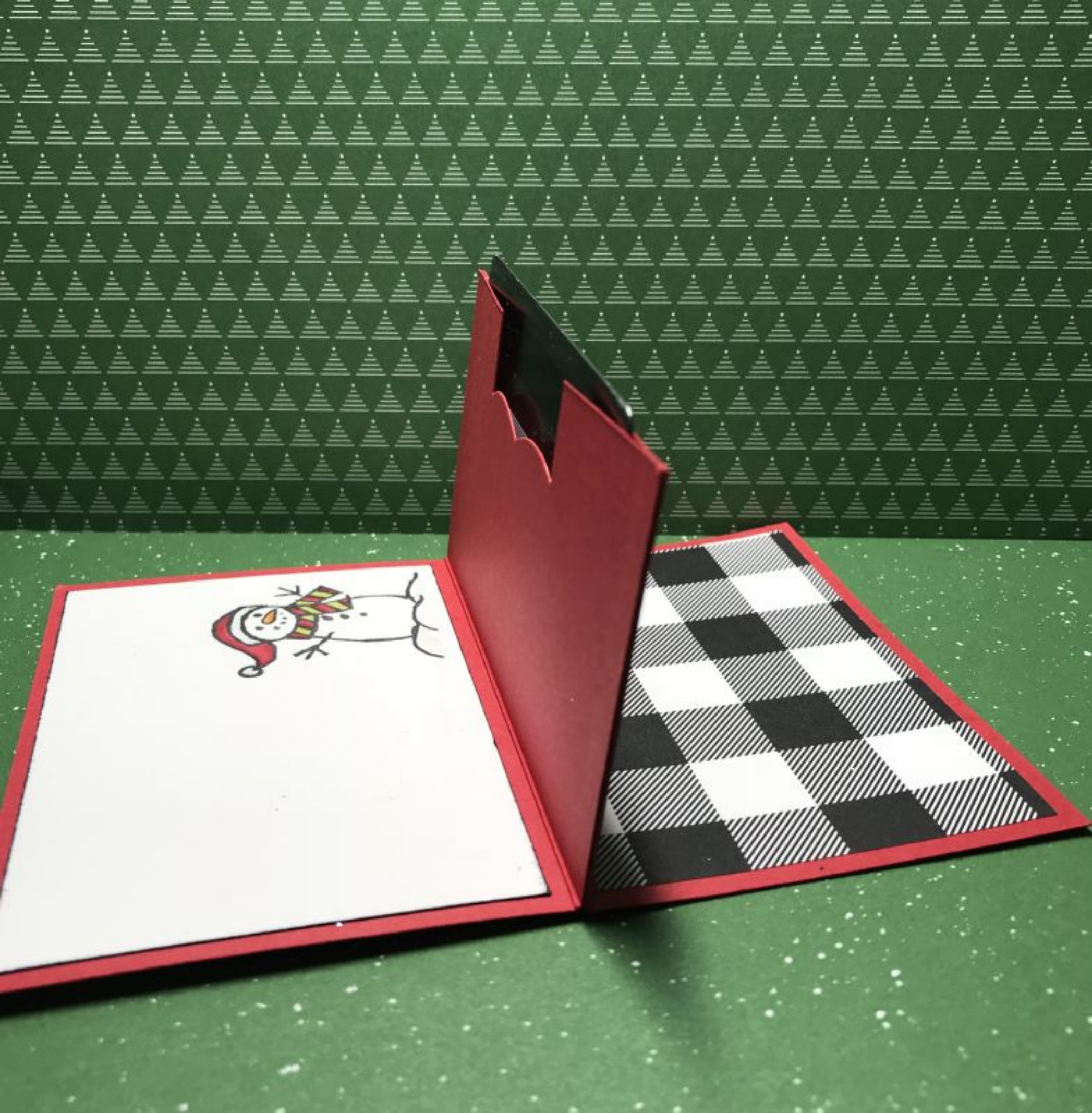
With your cutter, slice off about 1/16" from the folded edge.
You are cutting the fold off so you can insert your gift card.


That's all there is! The basics done and now all you have to do is embellish and decorate it any way that you want.

With some of the Gift Cards, I will to make a belly band around it by cutting about an inch of cardstock and wrap it around the whole gift card holder and cut off any excess. Stamp it, tie ribbon around it, or anything you want to create a unique gift card!
